**ORDER:**

Government in the G.O.s 1<sup>st</sup> to 4 read above extended certain concessions and exemptions to the Blind Deaf and Dumb and Physically Handicapped candidates for appearing 7<sup>th</sup> Class and 10<sup>th</sup> Class Examinations.

2. The Director of School Education, in his letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above, has stated that representations have been received for extension of some more concessions to the Physically handicapped candidates and requested the Government to issue suitable orders.

3. Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and hereby extend the following concessions in addition to the existing to the physically Handicapped candidates who appear for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> class Common/Public Examinations.

1. The qualifying criteria and pass marks in final examinations i.e., VII and X classes should be reduced from 35 to 20 (Twenty) marks for all subject to Blind, Deaf and Blind students.
2. The jumbling systems in examinations for all classes should be abolished in respect of these students and trained teachers should only attend the valuation of answer papers.
3. The scribe for the Blind should be X standard.
4. The exemptions to Deaf Students to study only one language and exemptions of fee and half-an-hour extra time each subject should be extended in all the classes i.e. VI to X.
