**AMENDMENT**

In item No.s 4.2(e) and 5.2(e) of the para 4 and para 5 of the G.O. Ms. No. 82Pr&Rd(RD.II) Department, dt. 25.3.2006 and G.O. Ms.No. 83, PR & RD(RD.II) Department, dt 27.3.2006 respectively the following shall be substituted / added.

**Disabled Pensions**

“ Irrespective of the age limit, Disabled pensions shall be given to disabled persons having a minimum of 40 % disability. In case of a minor child, the pension shall be disbursed to the mother/father of the disabled child”.
